MEETING RECORD OF JANUARY 16, 2019

1. CALL TO ORDER AND INTRODUCTIONS

Leslie Bruce (RRC), Co-Chair of the TGPC GWI Subcommittee, called the meeting to order at approximately 9:38 AM CST. GWI Subcommittee members were introduced. The representatives from the Texas State Soil and Water Conservation Board (TSSWCB), Bureau of Economic Geology of The University of Texas at Austin (UTBEG), Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation (TDLR), Texas Parks and Wildlife Department (TPWD), and United States Geological Survey (USGS) were not present at the meeting.

2. STATUS REPORTS

Agricultural Chemicals Task Force

Alan Cherepon (TCEQ) reported on the Agricultural Chemicals Task Force:

- The End-Of-Year (EOY) self-assessment and associated sampling reports were sent to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 6 in Dallas on September 27, 2018. The table-formatted EOY report for the FIFRA grant was sent to the TCEQ federal grants staff to incorporate into the Performance Partnership Grant (PPG) report on October 2, 2018.
- The proposed Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 Pesticide Monitoring Plan would include cooperative monitoring, and provided sufficient budget is available, atrazine monitoring in the corn and sorghum cropland of the Northern Panhandle Region, with a limited number of samples to include laboratory analysis by EPA Method 525.2. Other activities would include updating and conducting quality assurance and control activities on the Interagency Pesticide Database (IPD) and requesting pesticide water monitoring data from TCEQ programs and the USGS.
- The USGS FY2018 pesticide monitoring results from their website database were entered into the IPD and completed on November 8, 2018.
- TCEQ staff provided a table display and personnel for the annual Texas Plant Protection Conference in Bryan/College Station on December 4 5, 2018.
- Alan Cherepon (TCEQ) attended the U.S. EPA/States/Tribes pesticide meeting in Dallas on October 10 11, 2018, sharing Texas groundwater protection activities with other Region 6 states and the U.S. EPA.

TGPC Publications

Abiy Berehe (TCEQ) reported on the following TGPC publications:

- Activities and Recommendations of the Texas Groundwater Protection Committee: Report to the 86th Legislature ("Legislative Report", TCEQ publication SFR-047)
 - o The Legislative Report Subcommittee was activated to work on this report on January 10, 2018, and there were three Legislative Report Subcommittee meetings in 2018;
 - The final draft report was approved at the October 17, 2018 TGPC meeting; TCEQ staff completed the publication process and it is available online at https://www.tceq.texas.gov/assets/public/comm_exec/pubs/sfr/047-18.pdf; and,
 - o The report was distributed to the Texas Legislature in December 2018 before the session began on January 8, 2019.

- Texas Groundwater Protection Strategy ("Strategy", TCEQ publication AS-188):
 - O At the TGPC's quarterly public meeting October 17, 2018, the responses to the public comments regarding the proposed *Strategy* update were presented and approved; the Committee then approved the proposed *Strategy* update; the record of the meeting, including the Committee's responses to the public comments, can be found at http://bit.ly/2OJpr6q; and,
 - o The *Strategy* was published on November 30, 2018 and it is available online at https://www.tceq.texas.gov/assets/public/comm_exec/pubs/as/188.pdf.

3. SET FUTURE MEETING DATE

The next TGPC GWI Subcommittee meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, March 6, 2019, at 9:30 AM CDT, in TCEQ's Building F, Conference Room 2210.

4. DISCUSS CURRENT GROUNDWATER ISSUES

Water Supply Enhancement Program

Ken Rainwater (TTU) reported that the Water Supply Enhancement Program may be included in the new state budget.

Hydraulic Fracturing

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) reviewed the article in the handout package about "produced water" from oil and gas development activities in the West Texas Permian Basin. Diane Boellstorff (AgriLife Extension) reported that guidelines had previously been developed for applying produced water on agricultural land. John Tracy (AgriLife Research) reported that there had been a grant for applying produced water on agricultural land in the Rio Grande Valley, but the produced water was actually reused in the fracking process.

Emerging Contaminants

There was no discussion of this topic at this point in the meeting.

Saline Groundwater Trends and Impacts in Texas

There was no discussion of this topic at the meeting.

Agricultural Chemicals

There was no additional discussion of this topic at the meeting.

Border Groundwater

John Tracy (AgriLife Research) reported that they would have an updated draft of the *Transboundary Groundwater Resources along the Texas-Mexico Border* white paper at the next meeting.

Aquifer Storage and Recovery

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) reviewed the article in the handout package about an Aquifer Storage and Recovery (ASR) joint project between a city and a large company in Oregon.

Abandoned Water Wells

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) reviewed the article in the handout package about a child in Spain that had fallen down an abandoned water well and excerpts from the *Interim Report to the 86th Texas Legislature*, House Committee on Natural Resources (December 2018), regarding their recommendations about abandoned water wells, some of which were based on recommendations in the TGPC *Legislative Report*.

Failing Septic Systems

There was no discussion of this topic at this point in the meeting.

Others

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) reviewed the summary in the handout package about a USGS meeting regarding a geoenvironmental assessment of a portion of the Texas Gulf Coast Uranium Resources Pilot Study.

The GWI Subcommittee took a meeting break at approximately 10:21 – 10:31 AM CST. A quorum of designated TGPC representatives and alternates were present at the meeting and they were reminded not to discuss TGPC business during the break.

5. BUSINESS DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION

Final Draft *How is Groundwater Quality Affected by Failing On-site Sewage Facilities (OSSFs)*? White Paper

Anish Jantrania (AgriLife Extension) presented a final draft of the *How is Groundwater Quality Affected by Failing On-site Sewage Facilities (OSSFs)*? white paper. David Van Dresar (TAGD) proposed, David Villarreal (TDA) seconded, and all remaining members approved the white paper. The white paper would be presented to the TGPC for approval at their meeting later that day.

David Villarreal (TDA) reported that he had recently attended a National Rapid Response Teams meeting and suggested that there be future research on the proximity of failing OSSFs to food

production sites, as well as whole genome analyses of OSSF-associated bacteria, viruses, and protozoans and the recalcitrance or survivability of these microbes.

Draft How is Groundwater Quality Affected by Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS)? White Paper

Emily Hall (DSHS) presented an updated draft of the *How is Groundwater Quality Affected by Per- and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS)*? white paper, requested feedback on it, and indicated that a final draft would be presented at the next meeting.

Draft Transboundary Groundwater Resources along the Texas-Mexico Border White Paper

There was no additional discussion of this topic at the meeting.

Draft TGPC GWI Subcommittee Fiscal Year 2020 – 2021 Activity Plan

Kathy McCormack (TCEQ) presented the draft *TGPC GWI Subcommittee Fiscal Year* 2020 – 2021 Activity Plan and requested that members review it after the meeting in preparation for more discussion at the next meeting. Additional topics suggested for white paper development included brackish groundwater, endangered species, well flooding after disasters, and uranium mining.

Discussion of White Papers Under Development

There was no additional discussion of the white papers that were under development.
